Chaperone Responsibilities:

Welcome to an exciting 8 days / 7 nights with the KKHS and Kalama music programs! Thank you so much for volunteering your time and energy to help make this trip an unforgettable experience for our students. The following is a list of duties expected of all chaperones on this trip:

1. When at the airports, check to see that all baggage and instruments are tagged with an identification tag, airline tag, and teal yarn.
2. When at the airports, check that all students have their music binders with sheet protectors, instruments, accessories, concert uniform, and folding music stand.
3. When at the airports, check that all students have their personal belongings (carry-ons, cell phones, airline tickets, etc.).
4. Do a headcount of your group at all boardings (airplane, bus, etc.), lights outs, and meeting times.
5. **DO NOT TOLERATE VERBAL ABUSE OR DISRESPECT FROM ANY STUDENT.** If there are any problems, please let Mr. Nagata know as soon as possible.
6. Make sure that you know where your group is at any time we are outside the Universal Studios or Disneyland / DCA parks.
7. **IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY**, call 911 or take the student to a park staffer, doctor, or hospital immediately, whichever is more appropriate for the situation. If at a park, bring the situation up with a park staffer and call Mr. Nagata ASAP. If you cannot find or reach Mr. Nagata and the student needs to be moved, catch an uber or taxi with the student, text the chaperone group chat, and call the student's parents / guardians to keep them updated. Mr. Nagata will be there as soon as possible.
8. Female chaperones, please be ready to assist the girls in the group with any female needs should the situation arise.
9. Keep an eye out for any student who may not be eating regularly. A student may spend all their money on souvenirs or junk food and we want to make sure everyone remains healthy for the duration of the trip.
10. On a similar note, watch out for signs of dehydration (constant thirst, fatigue, dizziness, dry mouth, sunken eyes, etc.). We will be doing a lot of walking in the hot sun and some of our students may not be used to this.
11. If you find that a student is not feeling well, let the other chaperones (and Mr. Nagata) know via group chat so that we can help you keep an eye on the child. Sometimes students stay up too late or just get bored, but other times they may actually get sick (flu, food poisoning, etc.).
12. Watch out for unwanted drama between students (fighting, bickering, bullying, students being "iced out" of a group, etc.). Let Mr. Nagata know ASAP if you see this happening.
13. Check student rooms for any and all damages at both check-in and check-out times. If found, take a picture and text it to Mr. Nagata so that he can notify hotel management.
14. At check-out, check student rooms for excess trash and left-behind items or clothing.
15. Check on and under student seats anytime we leave an airplane or bus.
16. Make sure you are on time (or early) to all meetings. We want to set a good example for the students.
17. Know the itinerary and any changes made. If you see a potential problem, let Mr. Nagata know immediately.
18. There will be a short chaperone meeting / debrief in Mr. Nagata's room after every lights out.
19. Remind students to say "please" and "thank you."
20. Do not smoke, vape, or consume alcohol in front of the students.

Individual Chaperone Duties:

1. **Tipping:** _____
Responsible for tipping our drivers and hotel staff daily.
2. **Hotel Control:** _____ & _____
Makes wake-up calls for the group at the front desk, patrols the corridors before lights out, and reminds students about being good neighbors.
3. **Restaurant / Meal Control:** _____
Makes sure pizza, In-N-Out, and Medieval Times meals run smoothly and gets refreshments / snacks for chaperone meetings.
4. **Cargo Van:** _____ & _____
Rents and drives the van that holds our instruments, music binders, and uniforms.
5. **Detention / Home Base:** _____ & _____
Maintains the home base / detention center at Universal and Disneyland.
