Rules and Regulations King Kekaulike Music Program California Trip May 31 – June 7, 2023

Students will abide by the following rules and regulations so that they may stay safe and have fun on our trip to California, as well as ensure the safety and well-being of all other members in our traveling group.

- 1. All school and classroom rules and regulations will be in effect.
- 2. School dress code policy will be in effect.
 - Shoes and appropriate clothing for concerts and excursions.
 - Students that are deemed to be dressed inappropriately will be asked to change their clothes, stay back at the hotel, or stay home on Maui.
- 3. Always stay in groups of two or more while walking around Disneyland or Universal Studios.
- 4. Always stay with at least one chaperone while outside the theme parks.
- 5. Always make sure your main chaperone knows where you are.
- 6. Be punctual to group meetings.
- 7. Students will be responsible for loading/unloading baggage and equipment. Chaperones are there to supervise, not serve as free labor.
- 8. Always keep your hotel rooms, buses, and places that we visit clean and tidy. Do not litter!
- 9. There will be absolutely no smoking, vaping, gambling, and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages.
- 10. Girls are not allowed in the boys' rooms and boys are not allowed in the girls' rooms at any time.
- 11. Rooms keys will be returned to your chaperones 10 minutes before lights out.
- 12. Anyone caught breaking the law (shoplifting, vandalism, etc.) will be sent home immediately and face appropriate criminal charges/restitution.
- 13. Hotel balconies and pools are off limits!
- 14. When checking in/out of your room, please report all damages to your chaperone. Doing this when we check in is important so that you and your roommates will not have to pay for any damages that existed before we got there.
- 15. Swearing, insubordination, and all other forms of disrespect towards chaperones, hotel staff, bus drivers, etc. will not be tolerated. Chaperones are to notify Mr. Nagata immediately of any such incidents.
- 16. **Exercise the "Golden Rule."**
- 17. Remember to say "Please" and "Thank You."
- 18. Lack of Communication will not be tolerated!! If you are going to be late to a group meeting or get lost, text or call Mr. Nagata and/or a chaperone ASAP.

Caution: Bringing cell phones, video game systems, earbuds, or other expensive electronics will be done at your own risk! Don't be caught messing with your phone, game, or any other device while an adult is talking to you. It will be confiscated immediately.

Students who violate any of the above rules and regulations will be subject to:

- c. Be sent home on the next available flight *at your own expense*. Parents will be contacted to meet you at Kahului Airport.
